



## Mardi Gras Casino and Resort Vendor Policy

1. Mardi Gras is not responsible for unattended tables, lost, stolen or forgotten items. If anything remains on our property overnight, it will be at the vendor's own risk.
2. In the event you are forced to close by any government agency for failure to obtain your necessary permits and/or licenses, Mardi Gras is not liable and will not refund fees. No exceptions will be made to this because of failure to abide by local or state regulations.
3. Vendors must provide their own tents, tables, chairs, shade cover/tent, lights, etc.
4. Location of booth will be assigned by event coordinator.
5. No exclusives will be granted regarding booth location, space is limited and subject to approval.
6. Vendor is required to be open to the general public for the duration of the entire event. Closing to the public before the end of the event or staying open to the general public after the end of the event is grounds for exclusion from participating in future events.
7. Mardi Gras will not allow the sale of merchandise at the event that offends community standards or depicts drug use, weapons, political items, or related paraphernalia.
8. PHOTO RELEASE: The participants hereby give permission to Mardi Gras and its assignees to take photographs, make audio recordings and /or videos of the participants and their representatives or employees at the event and to use such photographs, audio recordings, and/or videos for such promotion or other lawful purpose as deemed appropriate.

All vendors must agree to the rules and requirements.
